Camp Mabuhay

Camp Mabuhay is an annual summer camp that provides adopted children with a unique opportunity to connect with their Filipino heritage, fostering a sense of identity, belonging, and forming lasting friendships with others who share similar experiences. Camp Mabuhay are held in Maryland, Connecticut, and Indiana.

Dance Ensemble

Dancers of all ages celebrate and promote the rich cultural heritage of the Philippines. By performing at a variety of venues, including community events, festivals, nursing homes, senior living communities, local schools, and libraries, the group not only showcases traditional Filipino dance but also fosters cultural awareness and appreciation in the wider community.

Harana Group

The Harana Group spreads joy and holiday spirit to the residents of local nursing homes through heartfelt performances of Filipino and Christmas songs. With their beautiful harmonies and warm presence, the group lifts the spirits of elderly individuals, offering them not only music but a sense of connection and community. This act of kindness and generosity fosters a brighter, more festive atmosphere, creating lasting memories for those who may feel isolated during the holiday season.

Mabuhay, Inc. Culture School (MICS)

MICS is a weekend program that runs from October to May, designed to enrich children ages 4-16 through cultural and educational experiences. Participants will explore Filipino-American and Philippine history, traditions, culture, and conversational Tagalog. The program also offers a variety of activities, including arts and crafts, cooking, music, folk dance, indoor and outdoor games, and field trips.

Membership

Members of Mabuhay, Inc. enjoy free and exclusive access to all programs, entertainment, and events, as well as valuable resources through various training sessions, workshops, and forums. Additionally, members have the opportunity to volunteer with the organization, fostering stronger relationships and a deeper sense of connection and engagement with fellow members, supporters, and the broader community.

Outreach

The Outreach Program offers and promotes opportunities for members to get involved and make a positive impact, particularly for underserved children and communities. This includes organizing initiatives like biannual dental mission and school supply drives at various locations in Maryland and the Philippines to name a few ongoing projects.

Seniors

The Seniors Program offers access to resources such as wellness initiatives focused on health, aging, and other topics relevant to older adults. Members also have opportunities to stay active and engaged in community outreach through activities like weekly community prayers, monthly Zumba or line dancing sessions, and singing at nursing homes or senior living communities with the Harana Group.
